To Whom it May Concern:

University of Connecticut School of Dental Medicine interns/residents/fellows employed by the Capital Area Health Consortium are statutorily immune from personal civil suit and liability and indemnified from personal expense arising out of their clinical activities, provided their actions:

- 1) are performed within the scope of their training;
- 2) occur at the University of Connecticut Health Center, John Dempsey Hospital, or a related University of Connecticut Health Center approved site where protection against professional liability claims is afforded only by state statute; and
- 3) are not wanton, reckless or malicious.

Coverage is for actions occurring during the intern/residency/fellowship period. Claims brought after this period are covered provided such claims arise out of intern/resident/fellow activities occurring during the training period. These protections have no dollar limit. Claims against the State, whether for professional or general liability, are pursued through the Office of the Claims Commissioner.

Likewise, the University of Connecticut School of Dental Medicine and its dentists, non-physician practitioners, and other professional staff are statutorily protected from personal liability and indemnified for personal expenses for claims arising out of acts or omissions in the discharge of their duties or within the scope of their employment, provided such acts or omissions are not wanton, reckless or malicious.
